Directions from East Valley: US 60 West to I-10 West. I-10 to Broadway Road exit. Left on Broadway Rd. to 48th Street. Left on 48th Street approximately ¼ mile to Cotton Center Blvd. Turn right on Cotton Center Blvd. Schaller Anderson building is the first left.

Directions from West Valley: I-10 eastbound to exit 153, (AZ143 and 48th Street). At the top of the off ramp turn right. Go south on 48th Street past the Broadway Road stoplight and follow directions above.
